Users will have access to the same core career tools as before but with new features for improved usability, including:

- **Personalized career assessments** focused on a user's interests, values, personality and workplace preferences.
- **Comprehensive career information**, including videos, articles, best practices and downloadable worksheets.
- **Job searching capabilities** via integration with Indeed.com, based on a user's assessment results.
- **Resume-editing software** that provides 5,000 templates and cover letter samples.

- Access to *Career Transitions* will continue until September 30.
- Access to both products from August 28 to September 30.

#### What actions do you need to take?

- Encourage your users to download saved resumes in *Career Transitions* before September 30. Gale will place a message in-product to help notify users.
