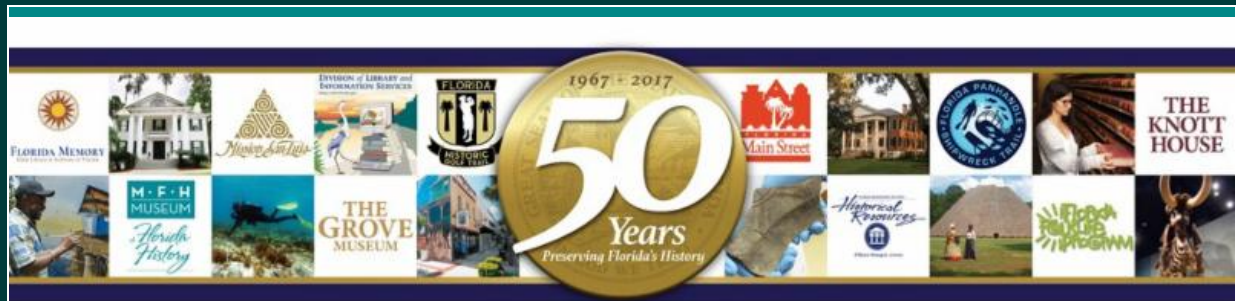

### Voter Registration Report Reminder

As part of the [National Voter Registration Act](#) (NVRA) and the [Florida Voter Registration Act](#) (FVRA), libraries are required to submit a quarterly report with the number of completed voter registration forms. This report can be submitted by e-mail to [VRA.Reporting@dos.myflorida.com](mailto:VRA.Reporting@dos.myflorida.com). Quarterly deadlines are listed below:

Quarter	Report Period	Due Date
1	January 1 - March 31	April 15
2	April 1 - June 30	July 15
3	July 1 - September 30	October 15
4	October 1 - December 31	January 15

The [Office of Head Start](#) has a mobile app that provides performance standards and strategies for preparing a child for school, information on local offices and more!

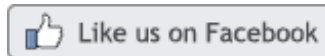
