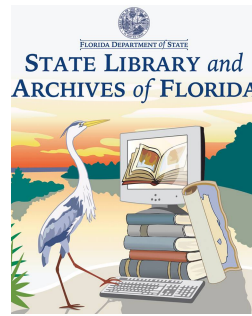

## State Government Records

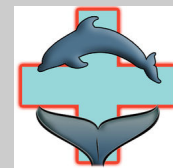
Are you looking for your next great read? Nothing goes

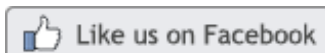
