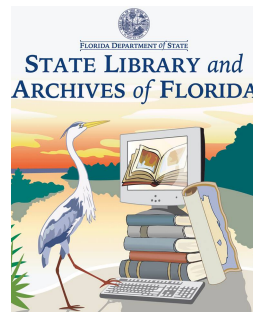
Cybersecurity Trends 2018

(SAMHSA) created an app called "Talk They Hear You" that provides a game environment that parents can practice with if they are having a difficult time talking to their teens about underage drinking.

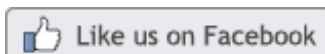
