Cybersecurity Quiz

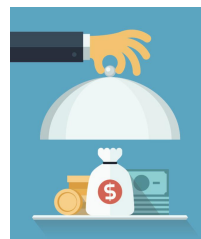

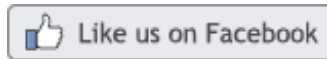
